

COLD WEATHER ACCOMODATION AGREEMENT

- 1. All delinquent accounts are subject to disconnection when the National Weather Service forecasted temperature will exceed 35 degrees for a 48-hour period during the winter unless a member requests a cold weather accommodation.
- 2. In order for a member to retain electric service when temperatures are above 35 degrees during the cold weather period (November 15th-March 15th), they must comply with the following cold weather accommodation provisions:
 - a. Inform Wheatland of their inability to pay their account in full.
 - b. Complete and sign a Cold Weather Accommodation Agreement.
 - c. Pay any outstanding billed deposit in full.
 - d. Pay ½ of each current bill during the cold weather period.
 - e. Past due balances including the bill due November 5th must be paid in full at the inception of the cold weather period.
 - f. Apply for federal, state or local funds for which the member may be eligible for.
 - g. Agree to make an arrearage payment plan or sign up for Wheatland Prepay Power Program at the conclusion of the cold weather period.
- 3. Members who do not adhere to the Cold Weather Accommodation rules are not eligible for payment arrangements at the conclusion of the cold weather period. Their entire outstanding balance, applicable fees and additional deposit if applicable are due and payable prior to reconnection if service is disconnected.
